

RING SIZE GUIDE

Find the size that fits you best

1. VISIT A JEWELLER

The most accurate method is to have your finger measured by a professional. We can also advise you according to the ring design you have chosen.

2. MEASURE YOUR FINGER

Wrap a thin strip of paper or string around the widest part of your finger. Mark where it overlaps, then measure the length in millimetres. This measurement corresponds to your European ring size.

3. MEASURE AN EXISTING RING

Choose a ring that fits the intended finger perfectly. Measure its inner diameter from one inside edge to the other through the centre, then find the corresponding measurement in the chart.

GOOD TO KNOW

- Measure preferably at the end of the day and when your hands are not cold.
- Finger size can differ from one hand to the other: always measure the finger on which the ring will be worn.
- If you are between two sizes, choose the larger size.
- For some wider ring designs, one size larger may feel more comfortable.
