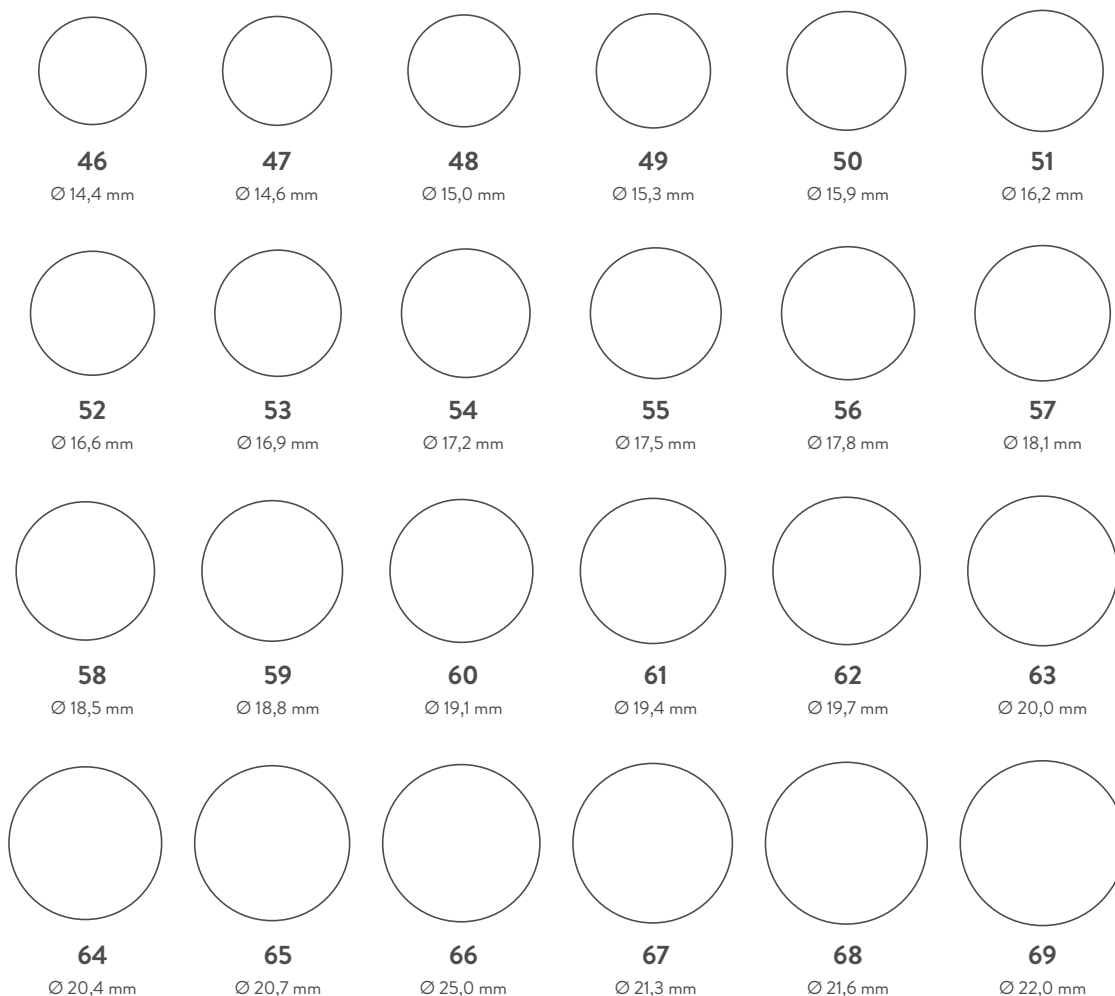


## SIZE GUIDE

1. Go to a professional. The easiest way, you can go to a professional, who can measure exactly the right size of each of your fingers. In addition, the service is free and the jewelers can advise you directly, depending on the model of ring you are looking for.
2. Measure the circumference of her finger. Take a tape measure and wrap around the finger that will wear the ring, at the joint (where the finger is thickest). Read the value in millimeters. For example, if your finger circumference measures 52 mm, your ring size is 52. Also, remember to take measurements at the end of the day, when your fingers are the most swollen. If you do not have a tape measure, instead of using a string, use a graduated strip ... Go around your finger, mark the limits and transfer the measurement on a graduated ruler to find out the circumference.
3. Already own a ring that fits perfectly on the desired finger?
  - a. Use it to measure your ring size.
  - b. Discover our virtual ring sizer online and place your ring on the circle with the closest diameter.
  - c. The Fabienne Belnou ring sizer must be printed on an entire A4 sheet with 100% scale. To verify that the ring sizer has been printed correctly, measure with a ruler the sample below. It must measure exactly 1 cm.
